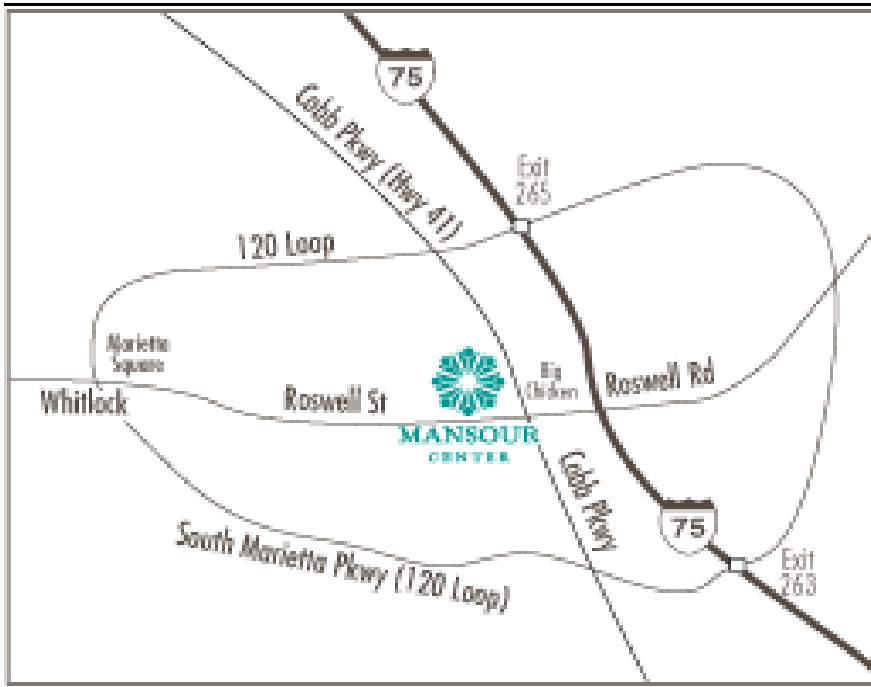

**From the North:** Take I-75 South to Exit 265 (North Loop) and turn Right onto GA 120 Loop West. Travel approximately 0.4 miles and then turn Left onto Cobb Parkway /US 41 South. Travel approximately 0.8 miles and turn Right onto Roswell Street NE (The Big Chicken will be on your Left as you turn onto Roswell Street). The Mansour Center is approximately 0.1 miles on the right.

**From the South:** Take I 75 North to Exit 263 ( South Loop ) and turn Left onto GA 120 Loop West. Travel approximately 0.8 miles then turn Right onto Cobb Parkway /US 41 North. Travel approximately 0.7 miles then turn Left onto Roswell Street NE (The Big Chicken will be on your Right as you turn onto Roswell Street). The Mansour Center is approximately 0.1 miles on the right.

**From the East** (Roswell/Alpharetta Area): Take GA 9/Alpharetta Highway to Marietta Highway/GA 120 West. Follow GA 120 West for approximately 10.9 miles. As you prepare to cross Cobb Parkway/US 41, The Big Chicken will be on your Right. The Mansour Center is located on the Right approximately 0.1 miles West of Cobb Parkway/US 41.

**From the West** (Dallas): Follow Charles Hardy Parkway/GA 120 East to a Left turn on West Park Square NE/GA5. Then turn Right onto South Park Square SE/GA 120 for approximately 1.5 miles. The Mansour Center is located on the Left approximately 0.1 miles before you reach Cobb Parkway/US 41. If you reach Cobb Parkway/US 41 and see The Big Chicken you have gone too far and need to turn around.



**Parking:** Park in front of The Mansour Center and enter through the main entrance.
